

RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS FOR CURBSIDE PICKUP

FIBER	Preperation Required
Newspapers	Bundled securely with string and placed in bin** or put in paper grocery bag
Magazines & catalogs, high gloss paper	Bundled securely with string or put on paper grocery bag and placed in bin** Shredded paper must be bagged
Mixed office paper, computer paper, junk mail, window envelopes	Bundled securely with string or put on paper grocery bag and placed in bin** Shredded paper must be bagged
All corrugated cardboard, chipboard (i.e. cereal/cracker boxes, shoe boxes) Egg cartons (cardboard)	Broken down, no larger than 2 feet by 2 feet, and securely bundled and placed in or next to recycle bin**
Phone books, paperback books, hard cover books, Brown paper grocery bags	Place inside bin
GLASS, PLASTIC, METAL	Preperation Required
Metal and Tin - Metal cans, foil, metal caps, pie tins	Wash out thoroughly and place in bins
Glass - Clear, brown and green bottles and jars	Wash out thoroughly and place in bins
Plastics - Milk jugs, laundry soap jugs, ketchup, pop bottles	Wash out thoroughly and place in bins
Scrap Metal - Small items (i.e. shovel, baking tins)	Separate, place next to or inside bin

**Household Hazardous Waste*

***Bundled material must be tied with string, twine, tape or rubber bands.*
